

Reminders for Advisors:

1. Registration will be completed online and hard copies sent to the Executive Director.
2. **Delegates may only sign up for one competition per category.** (The only exceptions are in the Recognition category and the State Event category)
3. There is not a limit on the number of competitors that a chapter can sign up for when there is a preliminary round. The preliminary round will eliminate down to a number set by the contest chair that is determined by scores and time constraints.
4. Competitions with limits include: MRC Partnership (3); Job Seeking Skills (3); Interviewing Skills (3); Community Awareness (3); Health Education (3); Outstanding HOSA Chapter (1); HOSA Happenings (1); Clinical Specialty (3); National Service Project (1).
5. All registration materials will be available to advisors on the Illinois HOSA website, www.illinoishosa.org, and a hard copy will have to be returned to the Executive Director.
6. The National HOSA software will be again this year to register conference attendees and score competitions using a standard deviation method that is recommended by National HOSA.
7. Some events may have different times and locations on the conference schedule, so read it carefully and plan accordingly. Conference schedule is tentative. A revised schedule, if needed, will be mailed to you before the conference. Any revisions will occur due to hotel or judge requirements.
8. We encourage early registration. Instead of waiting until February 1 to register your students, you may complete it beginning December 8.
9. Registration will be done online again this year. Please send a hard copy to April Sonnefeldt
10. The room rate this year is \$93.00 plus room tax per night.
