Preliminary Round

Purpose: The purpose of the event is two-fold: 1) To assist chartered associations with selecting their Voting Delegates, if a method does not already exist and 2) To encourage HOSA members to develop and apply their knowledge of the organization and Parliamentary Procedure to represent their chartered associations at the State Leadership Conference as an official Voting Delegate

- Rules and Procedures**
1. Competitors in this event must be active members of HOSA-Future Health Professionals, in good standing in the division in which they are registered to compete (Secondary or Postsecondary/Collegiate).
 2. Competitors must be familiar with and adhere to the "General Rules and Regulations of the National HOSA Competitive Events Program (GRR)."

Voting Delegate Selection Process

3. At the local level, the selection of Voting Delegates is at the discretion of the Chapter Advisor or as outlined by the Chartered Association's Bylaws and/or Policies and Procedures.
4. Dress Code for SLC: Competitors must be in official HOSA uniform.

Number of Voting Delegates Selected for SLC

5. Each chartered association shall be allowed to select qualified HOSA members to serve as Voting Delegates at the SLC based on the division membership chart below.

<u>Membership</u>	<u>Voting Delegates</u>
1-25	one (1)
26-100	two (2)
101-300	three (3)
301-500	four (4)
501-750	six (6)
751-1000+	eight (8)

Voting Delegate Responsibilities

6. All members who are selected by their Chapter Advisor to serve as Voting Delegates will follow the rules and items outlined in these guidelines.
7. Voting Delegates must review the Voting Delegate Packet prior to SLC. The Voting Delegate must sign the Voting Delegate Verification Form and send it to Illinois HOSA 2 weeks prior to the conference. Send the verification form via email to illinoishosa32+organizationalleadership@gmail.com
8. Voting Delegates will bring the Voting Delegate Packet with them to SLC.
9. At the State Leadership Conference, Voting Delegates MUST attend and participate in the following events in order to fulfill their duties as a Voting Delegate:

Monday of SLC 7:00-8:00 pm	Orientation
Monday of SLC 8:00 – 9:00pm	Meet the Candidates
Tuesday of SLC 8:00 -9:00am	Candidate Speeches
Tuesday of SLC 9:00-10:00pm	Ballot Submission
Wednesday of SLC 8:00-10:00am	Awards Session
10. At the State Leadership Conference, Voting Delegates who represent their chapter and complete all required activities will be recognized at the Awards Session.
